Reminders

Authorisation forms

Please return your authorisation forms for who is able to collect your child from school. We will not let anyone else take your child that is not listed. If there is a change to the day please let the LSA know in the morning or call the office and a message will be passed to your class teacher.

Nut Allergies

Can we remind you that we do have children and staff with severe nut allergies at school. Please make sure that packed lunches are completely nut free, including Nutella spread. Thank you.

Earrings

Children in Key Stage 2 are allowed to wear studs in their ears. However, due to health and safety reasons, these will need to be removed for PE.

Uniform

Please remember to label all pieces of school uniform clearly so that we are able to return items to the owner.

Rewards and Praise

We have a wide range of ways in which we will reward or praise your child whilst they are at school with us.

Team Points

Our school Teams are Red (Mercury), Blue (Neptune), Green (Jupiter) and Yellow (Saturn). The children will be rewarded with team points which they will tally on the wall in the classroom. This is then collected by Year 6 children who read out the weekly total in Celebration Assembly on Friday.

Golden Pen Award

Each week we celebrate the children's progress in handwriting. One child is chosen from each year group to receive a golden pen and a golden pen certificate during Celebration Assembly. Their amazing piece of handwriting will be displayed within school.

Blue Celebration Certificates

Once a week Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 have Celebration assembly where we celebrate the children's work from that week. A child will be chosen from each class to come up to the front and receive a certificate for their fantastic work.

Behaviour Minutes

Each class has a reward chart on their wall. Every time the class shows impeccable behaviour, a square on the chart is shaded. After twenty shaded squares, the class receive a twenty minute reward; after 45 more shaded squares, they receive a forty-five minute reward; after ninety further shaded squares, they receive a ninety minute reward.
